










Minimum 4 guests to have exclusive use of Shakawa Lodge, less than 4 guests could be sharing with other guests.

All prices are in US dollars and exclude VAT (14%) on daily rates only.

Reservations

A deposit of 50% is payable on the booking date. Final payment must be made on arrival of the group in South Africa.

Cancellations

Cancellations must be made in writing at least eight weeks before departure. Failure to comply will result in the whole deposit being forfeited.
